

Lake & Pond Colorant - Blue

Enhances and Beautifies Directions for Use

Use rubber gloves to avoid staining of hands. Apply at a rate of 1 quart per 3-acre-feet of water. More or less can be used to attain desired look. Pour Lake and Pond Colorant directly into the water at several locations to improve dispersion.

Determine water volume in acre feet as follows: Length (L) x Width (W) x Average Depth (D)

43,560 sq. ft.

Background water color such as tannic acid or muddy water will reflect the color of dyed water.

Benefits:

- Sharper and cleaner natural reflection.
 - Deep lake like appearance.

Water Use & Restrictions

Allow several hours for dye to disperse before swimming, fishing, or irrigation.

Treated water will not stain exposed surfaces. Chlorinated water will cause fading, requiring larger dosages or more frequent treatments.

Storage

KEEP FROM FREEZING. Freezing can cause container to rupture. Store in a cool, dry place. Keep product closed tight when not in use.

CAUTION KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN

Avoid contact with skin. if product comes into contact with skin wash thoroughly. Most surfaces, small stains caused by accidental spillage can be removed by liquid bleach solution. In case of eye contact wash eye thoroughly with water. If irritation persists contact a physician. May be harmful if swallowed.
